

CRWGA STANDING RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

The Standing Rules are an adjunct to the By-Laws and shall govern in all matters to which they are applicable.

Play Guidelines

USGA Rules shall govern all play unless otherwise posted. All putts must be holed out (no Gimmes or Mulligans).

1. **Breaking Ties:** All ties will be broken according to USGA recommendations:
 - a. Back 9
 - b. Last 6
 - c. Last 3
 - d. Number 18

2. **Distance Measuring Devices:** Distance measuring devices may be used to measure distance only.

3. **Sign-Up:** Players must sign up 4 p.m. Friday for play on Monday and 4 p.m. Tuesday for play on Thursday. If you must cancel Monday or Thursday mornings, please call the Pro Shop at 520-393-1966, if no answer then please contact the play day coordinator. If you cancel before league day then contact the play day coordinator. *At the time of sign-up for league play each player must designate what teeing ground she chooses to play from, unless otherwise directed. (You may play from any tee that is rated for women, but any game that needs a gross score must be played from the red tees) If you do not designate a tee at sign-up you will be assigned to play from Red Tees.*

4. **Guests:** A guest may play 3 times a year with CRWGA but will not participate in weekly game or payouts. They may compete in the daily chip-in pot.

5. **Games:** Games will be equally distributed between individual and team games.

6. **Payouts:** In weekly league play a minimum of 1/3 of the field will be awarded and will be a fair and equitable payout across the field. On Low Gross/Low Net days equal payouts will be made between Gross and Net.

7. **Maximum Handicap:** Players will play to a maximum course handicap of 36 for all league play.

8. **Adjusting Scores for Handicap During Play & Maximum for posting:** If a player does not finish a hole, or her competitor concedes a stroke, she shall record the score she most likely would have made. This score is preceded by an "X". This score shall not exceed her max score of double bogey plus handicap strokes for the hole being played for posting.

9. **Posting Scores:** A player is responsible for posting her individual adjusted Gross Scores on the USGA Handicap System as soon as possible after play for every round she plays, except on League days. On League Days the game person will post your score, Monday and Thursday. All scores shall be posted for rounds of:
- 9 Holes or 18 Holes
 - 10 - 17 completed holes (must choose this option on GHIN when posting your score and you must enter these hole by hole)
 - Away and Competition scores

NOTE: "Practice Round" is taken to mean the round played prior to a tournament as a means to assess course characteristics.

To maintain the integrity of the WHS (World Handicap System), every round played under the USGA Rules of Golf, league or non-league, is a score to be posted.

10. **Chip-Ins:** The ball must be off the green and chipped (or putted) into the hole. A chip-in is only counted if the ball has not already resided on the green. For example, if the ball resided on the green, was then hit off the green, and then hit back on; this does *not* constitute a chip in. To participate in chip-ins you must have signed up and paid prior to golf. Carryover for chip-ins are Monday to Monday and Thursday to Thursday.
11. **Hole in One:** A Hole-in-One is official on any league day and qualifies for the Hole-in-One fund, provided the player has contributed to the fund. The ace must be made on league day and be witnessed by at least one person. Participation is voluntary, cost is \$4. Hole-in-One player will receive \$100.00. Recollection from members will be requested after a hole-in-one has been made.
12. **Ringer:** The Ringer is a season-long eclectic scoring, bettering your gross score hole by hole by tee box. There will be 2 ringer seasons: April 15-Oct 14 and Oct 15-April 14. Participation is optional per season. The cost to participate is \$3.00 per tee box entry. Ringer participants will be flighted at the beginning of each season. A Ringer chairperson will document scores on Monday and Thursday league days and present awards at season end.
13. **Inter-club:** Inter-club is a summer competition among local ladies' leagues. The format will be determined each year by participating Inter-club Captains. To be eligible for Inter-club, you have to have played at least 5 rounds with CRWGA in the Calendar Year. When necessary, qualifying rounds will be held to determine the team players for each event. Qualifying is by 'tee of choice'. Qualifying days will be determined by our leagues Inter-club Captains.
14. **Inclement Weather:** Players are responsible for being at the course and ready to play on time. If there will be a delay, players will be notified *via email* as soon as that information becomes available, however, we suggest in the winter months you call the pro shop's 'Frost Delay Hotline' at 520-352-1082, to hear a pre-recorded message with advice as to the projected time delay. Please be aware that much of the time the catch up with tee times is quicker than the prediction.

15. **Tee Markers:** If your group is first on the teeing ground, please take a minute to make sure the markers are placed properly in relationship to the flag, heading in the right direction, spaced out properly, no branches hanging overhead or behind you, and at least two (2) club lengths from the back or front of the teeing ground. If you are not the first group on the tee the markers must remain as placed.

Tournaments

To qualify for play in major tournaments, entrants must be an active league member and have at least 5 league play days (not including tournaments) during the preceding 12 months (see Article VII in By-Laws for detailed information).

1. **Club Championship:** Will be a 36-hole Gross/Net Stroke Play competition. Tournament will be flighted by handicap and played from the **Red** tees. There will be an entry fee for participation in this tournament.
2. **Medallion State Tournament:** All members of the Association are automatically members of the AGA, therefore all are eligible to play, this is not a league tournament. The local Medallion tournament is played in four rounds. Two best rounds out of four are used to determine the winner. The best **Gross** and **Net** scores are used to determine the winners who will be invited by the league to play in the state tournament. The maximum index used for this tournament shall be **40.4**. This tournament will be played from the **Red** tees.
3. **Telegraph Tournament:** Participants must be members of Southern District. This is a net event and shall be conducted between October 1 and May 1. This tournament will be played from tee of choice.
4. **El Conquistador del Sud (Eclectic):** Participants must be members of Southern District. This is a 2-day net ringer event. Shall be conducted between October 1 and May 1. This tournament will be played from tee of choice.
5. **Other tournaments may be added throughout the year, such as Match Play or a No-Frills Member-Guest, etc.**

Member Conduct

As a member of CRWGA you are expected to conduct yourself in a respectful manner exhibiting courtesy to others and good sportsmanship.
